Raleigh, NC – A design by watercolor artist Linda Dallas, entitled “Fruition”, was recently chosen for the City public art project, ART-ON-THE-MOVE. Original designs by local artists were selected by the City of Raleigh Arts Commission, in partnership with Capital Area Transit (CAT), for the project.

ART-ON-THE-MOVE places original art on the sides of a handful of CAT buses for a period of six months. The designs can already be seen on buses throughout the streets of Raleigh. The official unveiling will occur as part of the Artsposure annual arts festival in Raleigh on May 21, 2011.

“I’m delighted that my image of fruits and vegetables will be cruising down the street on a Capital Area Transit bus,” stated Dallas. “I create paintings to celebrate the foods that grace my table everyday. Art-On-The-Move is helping me extend that celebration citywide.”

All artwork submissions for ART-ON-THE-MOVE were reviewed by a panel comprised of community members and representatives from the Arts Commission and CAT. Final selections were recommended by the review panel, and approved by the Arts Commission and the Raleigh Transit Authority.

Linda Dallas has lived in Raleigh, NC for 22 years. She has taught drawing, illustration, design fundamentals and watercolor workshops at schools and art centers across North Carolina including NC State University, Meredith College, and Artspace. For twelve years, Linda developed exhibits for Exploris (now Marbles) museum in downtown Raleigh. In 2008, she was the recipient of a United Arts Regional Artist Project Grant. Dallas is a signature member of the Watercolor Society of North Carolina. Her work is widely exhibited. Most recently, her work was selected for the prestigious national exhibition Watercolor USA 2011. She is currently an Assistant Professor of Visual Arts with Saint Augustine’s College.
